The AutoCAD LT program, specifically designed to run on a personal computer, and AutoCAD Classic, which is a powerful, but time-consuming and slow program that requires a licensed version of AutoCAD. In 2007, AutoCAD LT was removed from the product line, and the Classic version was renamed AutoCAD as it includes features that are available only in the Professional version. AutoCAD is available on a subscription model. A user pays for a license for the software and a maintenance plan that allows the user to use the software for the specified time. AutoCAD subscribers can use AutoCAD to create drawings, use features of the software, or access parts of the Internet that they may need while using AutoCAD. There is also a trial version of AutoCAD, which is free for 30 days. After the trial period, the AutoCAD subscription model is then available. History AutoCAD and the AutoCAD LT program were originally developed by Inventec Inc. of Taiwan and released to the public in 1984. It was one of the first CAD systems to be released for the Macintosh platform in 1986. Inventec was acquired by Autodesk in 1998. Autodesk also acquired the rights to the old DOS, Windows and Macintosh versions of the AutoCAD program. All operating systems and versions are now the property of Autodesk. The first version of AutoCAD known as Version 1, which was developed between 1984 and 1986, was sold with an Inventec V100 (a color graphics tablet) and featured a menu-driven software user interface (an early example of a menu bar). During 1988–1990, AutoCAD was updated to Version 2, which introduced the current 3D graphics and AutoCAD LT. Other new features included the ability to view two-dimensional drawings on a three-dimensional sheet of paper, a command-driven user interface and the ability to create a new drawing with a simple keyboard shortcut. The final major release was AutoCAD 1996, which added complex 3D drafting and site development tools and a wide range of new features. The software was originally developed on the then-revolutionary Macintosh platform and was subsequently ported to the IBM PC platform in 1990.
