Consistent with research on the relationship between alcohol use and accidents, we showed that accidents were more frequent among men who drank frequently than among those who drank sporadically, a relationship that became stronger when other measures of drinking were considered, such as heavy drinking occasions and number of drinks. This result was largely independent of occupational hazards, which may have reduced the validity of the findings. However, the strong consistency of the association between drinking pattern and accidents across several measures suggests that it is not likely to be due to chance. While these results confirm those of previous studies and add to them by providing evidence that drinking patterns are related to other types of accidents, the findings should be interpreted with caution. Occupational accidents, by definition, are less severe than traffic accidents and are therefore harder to detect and measure. In any case, the analyses were done for all accidents, which may have compromised the validity of the conclusions. The effects of drinking on occupational accidents could be greater if the sample included only those who were not at work when the accident occurred. It is likely that the association between drinking pattern and accidents is not causal, but rather reflects a confounded relationship between drinking and accidents. If frequent drinking were associated with accidents and frequent accidents were associated with heavy drinking, the latter explanation would be more plausible than the former. That is, frequent accidents would be a result of heavy drinking and heavy drinking would be a result of frequent accidents.
